Legacy Memberships and Endowments



Since 2002, the Auburn University **Women's Philanthropy Board** has offered educational programs for the community and beyond, sponsored mentoring initiatives for students, and practiced collective philanthropy in support of the College of Human Sciences. These efforts were made possible because of hundreds of individuals and companies who have invested in WPB's mission to educate, empower, and inspire.

As WPB looks forward to its next 20 years, it seeks to build on its historic role at Auburn University and the tradition of philanthropy that it represents by offering **WPB Legacy memberships**. Legacy memberships are funded through fund for excellence endowments established with the Auburn University Foundation. A Fund for Excellence carries the name of the donor (or a designee) and establishes the donor (or designee) as a WPB Legacy member in perpetuity.

Funds for Excellence are established with a \$25,000 minimum gift, payable over a five year period with gifts of cash, stocks, qualified charitable distributions from retirement accounts or other assets. Endowed funds forever remain for the support of WPB and its educational, mentoring, and philanthropic mission. The endowment fund is invested and earnings provide a permanent source of financial support to the Women's Philanthropy Board.
